Family Devotion — Lesson 11

MEMORY VERSE—GENESIS 7:16

“And they that went in, went in male and female of all flesh, as God had commanded him: and the LORD shut him in.”

- Although the world at this time was wicked and evil, a man by the name of Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.
- Grace is God’s kindness to an undeserving person.
- “And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart. And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them. But Noah found **grace** in the eyes of the LORD” (Genesis 6:5-8).
- “By **faith** Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with **fear**, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith” (Hebrews 11:7).
- After Noah finished building the ark, animals came on the ark along with Noah and his family.
- Noah accepted God’s grace by faith and reaped the benefits of being saved from the flood.
- Just as Noah was saved by the ark, we are saved from hell by believing in Jesus.

- What were three things Noah had in his life that we should have? (Faith—Fear—Obedience)
- What did Noah never see before he built the ark? (Gen. 2:5)
- What does the rainbow represent? (Gen. 9:12-16)
